

# Father Tom's Tidbits

Every three years the diocesan priests from the Archdiocese of Chicago meet. The convocation begins this Monday and concludes on Thursday. It will be held at Pheasant Run Resort in St Charles. Father Charles will be covering the parish when I am away.

Our parish will be hosting theology on Tap this summer. The first session will be Sunday, July 10. The speaker and topic are still unknown. The first session will begin with a barbecue on the parish grounds followed by the talk at 7 pm. This is for the young adults of our parish.

Several teens and adults from our parish will be going to Champaign IL to do volunteer work for a week through Catholic Heart Work camp the week of July 17th. It will be a week of praying, socializing, eating and doing volunteer work. The experience is so enriching that teens are anxious for next summer to arrive so they can go again. During the month of July the school building (the original wing) will be closed for summer cleaning. The building will reopen in August nice and clean ready for the teachers and students to begin a new year. The new section of the school will be cleaned the middle of July. The parish center /gym will be cleaned after Donut Sunday.

The present teacher's lounge is in the process of being converted into the three year old classroom. The Religious Education storage room will become the teacher's lounge. Extended Day Care program will remain in the Holy Child Center. Having the three year olds in the main building is much safer and also makes the little people feel more a part of the school. George Kashmar, the parish business manager is no longer with us. George is the business manager of St Patrick Parish just down the street from us. George accomplished much in his brief time here. The majority of the recent improvements in the buildings and on the parish grounds were under the guidance of George. Those parishioners who have had contact with George know that he is very outgoing and always willing and eager to help people. Our parish has been blessed with his presence and the parishioners of St. Patrick will be blessed with his presence.

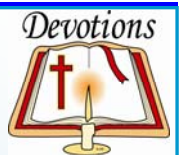

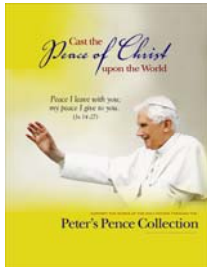
## Respect Life Rosary
